SEXUAL VIOLENCE RAPE-CRISIS CENTER

Independence House is a Massachusetts Rape Crisis Center and provides immediate on-site support for rape and sexual assault victims seeking assistance at any Barnstable County police station or hospital.

All Sexual Violence Rape-Crisis Center services are offered to survivors over the age of 12, all gender, all partners, family and friends. Sexual Violence includes:

 stalking
 molestation
- sexual harassment
- intimate partner sexual abuse
- childhood sexual abuse

Included in the Center's program:

- individual counseling
- survivor group counseling
- secondary survivor group counseling
- advocacy
- crisis intervention
- assessments and referrals

All activities are individualized to each person's situation.

SEXUAL VIOLENCE RAPE-CRISIS CENTER

Sexual assault is an incredibly personal act of violence which can occur in many ways. Statistics suggest that 1 in 6 women and 1 in 33 men will be sexually assaulted during their lifetime. Further, every 2 minutes in our country, a woman is a victim of a completed rape. Most rapes are committed by an acquaintance, friend or family member, and although common, sexual assault and rape are crimes often unreported.

If you have been sexually assaulted and would like to speak to a counselor immediately, the Independence House hotline (800.439.6507) is staffed with a counselor 24/7/365.

Immediate onsite crisis intervention & support Independence House Medical/Police Accompaniment Services for rape crisis, provides a specialized, trained advocate who will meet you at the hospital or police station and offer free and confidential information and support. The advocate will also work closely with the Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) at the hospital and help you to understand options.
